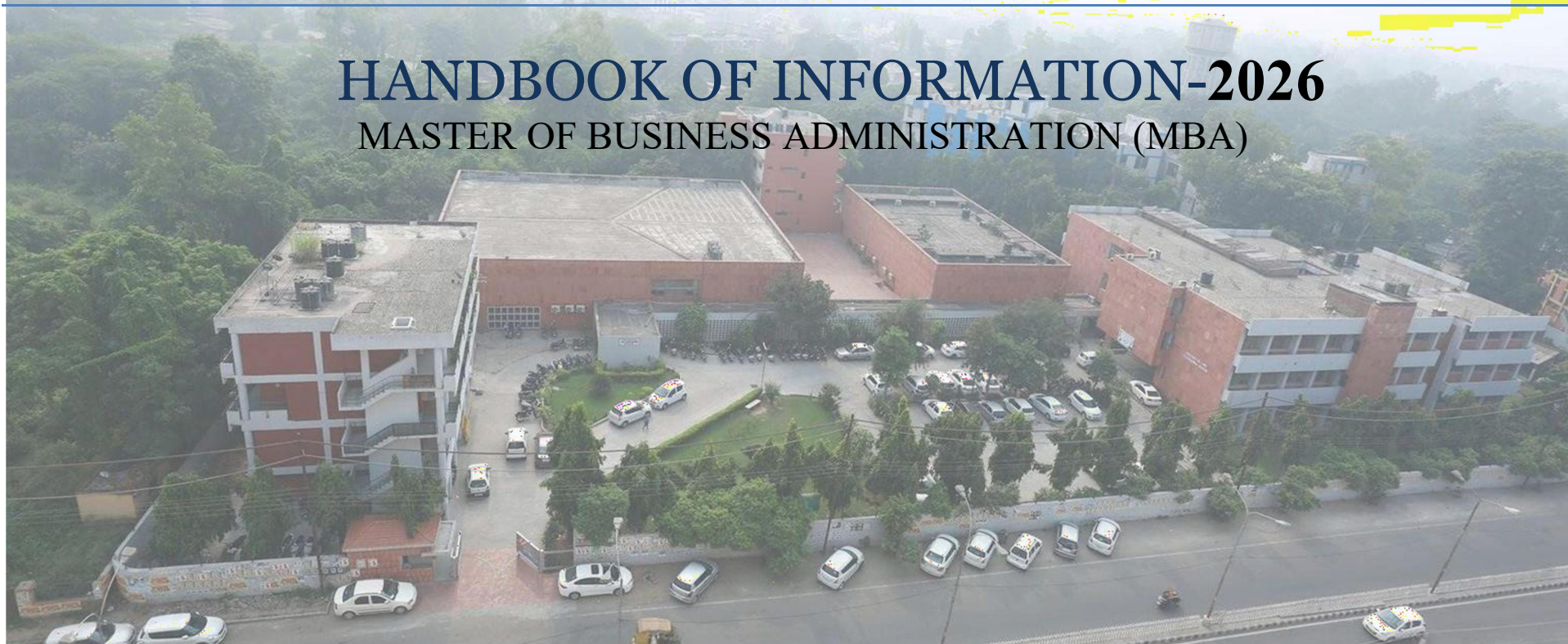



ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION

Master of Business Administration (MBA)

THE MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION WOULD BE AS FOLLOWS:

- a) i) A Bachelor's Degree in any discipline of the University or a degree of any other University which has been recognized by the Syndicate as equivalent there to with not less than 50% marks (45% for SC/ST/BC/PWD) in the aggregate. Provided that in the case of candidates having Bachelor's degree of the University through Modern Indian Languages [Hindi/Urdu/Punjabi (Gurmukhi script)] and/or in a Classical Language (Sanskrit/Persian/Arabic) or degree of any other University obtained in the same manner recognized by the Syndicate, 50% marks in the aggregate shall be calculated by taking into account full percentage of marks in all the papers in Language excluding the additional optional paper, English and the elective subject taken together.

OR

- ii) A pass in the final examination conducted by the (a) Institute of Chartered Accountants of India or England, (b) Institute of Cost and Works Accountants of India or England, or (c) Institute of Company Secretaries of India.

OR

- iii) AMIE Examination with 50% marks or more after having passed the diploma examination with 60% marks or above and having at least 5 years of research/teaching or professional experience.

AND

- b) i) Candidate must have appeared in CAT-2025, followed by an appearance in the Group Discussion and Personal Interview.

OR

- ii) Candidate must have appeared in any of the MAT examination conducted by AIMA during the academic year 2025-26, followed by an appearance in the Group Discussion and Personal Interview.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Candidate must fulfill both the criteria given in (a) and (b) above to be eligible for admission.

FEE STRUCTURE

(Subject to approval of competent authority)

1. Other than NRI Rs.1,03,335/-* payable through **Demand Draft in favour of The Registrar, Panjab University, Chandigarh, payable at Chandigarh** at the time of admission, towards payment of the tuition fee and other university charges for Ist Semester. Fee installment of Rs. 96,690/-*, Rs.1,03,335/-* & Rs.96,690/-* for MBA IInd, IIIrd & IVth Semester respectively is to be deposited on the dates, as and when notified by the University.

Further, the candidate will have to deposit Rs. 30,000/- (Rs.15,000/- per year) by **Demand Draft in favour of MBA SFC LDH payable at Ludhiana**, towards placement activities, guest lectures, industrial/study/educational visits, Alumni Meet, and other students' related activities and department development work.

2. NRI

For NRI candidates, the total fee is US \$ 6,000* per year. This consists of a tuition fee of US\$ 5,400* and a Student Development Fund (Non-refundable) of US\$ \$600* per year, A Registration fee of US\$ 1100 will also be charged from those who have passed the qualifying examination from a university or institution other than Panjab University. A fee is to be paid through **Demand Draft in favour of The Registrar, Panjab University, Chandigarh, payable at Chandigarh**.

Further, the candidate will have to deposit Rs.30,000/- (Rs.15,000/-per year) by **Demand Draft in favour of MBA SFC LDH payable at Ludhiana**, towards placement activities, guest lectures, industrial/study/educational visits, Alumni Meet, and other students' related activities and department development work.

*** NOTE:** Fee Structure for the session 2026-27 has not been finalized by the University as on date and is subject to change. The final fee structure will be put on the website of UBS Ludhiana. The candidate will have to pay the exact amount as per PU fee structure prevailing at the time of admission duly approved by PU authorities. Changes can be made to the existing rules, according to rules as given in the "Handbook of Information & Rules for Admissions 2026" of the Panjab University, Chandigarh.

ADMISSION PROCESS

1. Admission for this course will be based on the merit of the scores secured by the candidates in the Common Admission Test (CAT) 2025 conducted by IIM Kozhikode or Management Aptitude Test (MAT) 2025-26 conducted by All India Management Association (AIMA), New Delhi followed by Group Discussion and Personal Interview (GD & PI). All candidates aspiring to apply for the MBA Programme at UBS, Ludhiana, must take the CAT-2025 or any of the MAT conducted during the academic year 2025-26. However, the candidates having CAT scores shall be considered for merit determination in preference to the MAT score. The candidates are advised to visit UBS, Ludhiana admission website <http://ubsldhadmissions.puchd.ac.in>, for detailed instructions & procedures for participation in the admission process. **The hard copy of the application along with necessary documents should reach Director, University Business School, Panjab University Regional Centre, Civil Lines, Ludhiana-141001 latest by 20th April, 2026 upto 04:00 p.m.** Thereafter, no application shall be accepted. Panjab University shall not be responsible for any postal delay in delivery or loss in transit of application form.
2. The candidates will be called for Group Discussion and Personal Interview on the basis of their score in the CAT-2025/ MAT 2025-26.
3. The number of candidates to be called for Group Discussion and Personal Interview on the basis of merit in CAT – 2026/ MAT 2025-26 will be equal to eight times the total number of seats in each category or the total number of eligible candidates, whichever is lower.

Explanation: While working out the percentage of seats in the reserved category (refer to guidelines for percentage of reserved/open seats), if the number arrived at contains a fraction, the same shall be resolved as follows the fraction is 0.5 or more, it shall be rounded off to 1; if it is less than 0.5, it shall be ignored. This shall, however, not affect the total number of seats in the General Category. To ensure this, if the total number of seats after making this adjustment, exceeds the prescribed number fixed for the course, the necessary additional seats shall be created with the prior permission of the D.U.I./Vice-Chancellor, such seats, if created, shall be treated as additional only for the year in question. The additional seats, if required to be created, shall be created only for the reserved category and not for the general category. Such additional seats, if remain unfilled, will not be converted to the general category.

4. The Group Discussion and Personal Interview of the shortlisted candidates will be held at the University Business School, Panjab University Regional Centre, Ludhiana. The invitation for attending GD/PI and the schedule of GD/PI will be put on <http://ubsldhadmissions.puchd.ac.in> only. Alerts about the schedule of GD/PI would be sent to the registered email address of the candidates. No other communication shall be made in this context.

Attendance in Group Discussion and Personal Interview is a must. If any candidate does not attend any one of the components, GD or PI, his/her candidature shall stand cancelled.

5. A Final Merit List of all the candidates who appeared in GD & PI will be prepared category-wise based on their combined aggregate score in the CAT-2025/ MAT 2025-26, Group Discussion, and Personal Interview.
6. The weightage for CAT/ MAT, Group Discussion and Personal Interview for preparing the final Merit List for admission will be as follows:

Written Test (CAT/ MAT)	85% (of CAT/ MAT PERCENTAGE SCORE & NOT PERCENTILE)	
Group Discussion	7.5%	
Personal Interview	7.5%	

In case of a tie, the following rules would apply:

- (i) A candidate getting higher percentage in the qualifying examination shall rank higher in order of merit.
- (ii) That if the marks in the qualifying examination are also the same then the candidate obtaining more marks in the immediate lower examination shall rank higher in order of merit.
- (iii) That if two or more candidates secure equal marks in (i) & (ii) above, the candidate senior in age shall rank higher in order of merit.

Note: When the provisional list of the candidates (based on merit) is displayed on the notice board, the Director shall mention the fact that this list is subject to change on account to improvement of result of the qualifying examination wherever applicable. Then result must be presented at the time of interview/operationalization of the waiting list.

Admissions shall be made strictly based on merit.

- 7. The eligibility of a candidate shall be provisional at every stage of the admission process. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure his/her eligibility and fulfillment of various conditions for admission as prescribed in the Rules / Regulations of the University. Admission can be cancelled at any stage in case the candidate is not found to be eligible.
- 8. (a) The final combined category-wise result of the candidates is expected to be notified in April/ May 2026 (tentative). Information about the counselling date(s) for admission shall be displayed on UBS Ludhiana website and the candidates are advised to regularly browse UBS, Panjab University Regional Centre, Ludhiana website <http://ubsldhadmissions.puchd.ac.in>.
(b) Candidates shall have to fulfill the eligibility conditions at the time of admission, failing which their candidature shall not be considered for admission even after they have gone through all the stages of the admission process. During the counseling, candidate is required to appear personally for counselling. However, in case a student has to appear in a final examination or is facing an extreme hardship, he/she has to seek permission of the **Director, UBS, Panjab University Regional Centre, Ludhiana** in advance, with documentary evidence. Further, he/she can send an authorized representative carrying a notarized authority from the candidate with authentication of the signature of the authorized representative. Admission to MBA, will be offered strictly according to the combined Merit List. The candidates appearing in their final degree examinations/qualifying examinations whose result is not declared at the time of counseling shall be admitted provisionally subject to submission of the result of the qualifying examination positively by **August 31, 2026 or any such date notified by the P.U. authorities*** for submission of documents.
- 9. (a) Information about the seats falling vacant, if any, after start of the classes and counseling date(s) to fill up these seats shall be displayed on the admission website: <http://ubsldhadmissions.puchd.ac.in> **CANDIDATES ARE ADVISED TO BROWSE WEBSITE <http://ubsldhadmissions.puchd.ac.in> REGULARLY FOR UPDATES.**
(b) The seats of those candidates' who are admitted provisionally and fail to submit the result of the qualifying examination by **August 31, 2026 or any such date notified by the authorities*** with the permission of the Vice- Chancellor, by 12.00 noon, shall stand cancelled without any notice. Resultant vacant seat/s, if any, shall be filled strictly according to the merit from those who are present at 04.30 p.m. on that day. Information about the seat/s falling vacant due to the non- submission of the result of the qualifying examination or any other reason on last date **which is likely to be August 31, 2026 or any such date notified by the authorities*** will be displayed on online Notice Board only. It is the candidates' responsibility to be present in University Business School, Panjab University Regional Centre, Ludhiana, during counseling and keep a watch for such vacant seats.

10. For admission to the Sports Category, please see the detailed guidelines for admission to the reserve category of sport on Page 38.
11. In the Defence Category, all the applicants fulfilling the eligibility conditions (i.e. the minimum eligibility criterion for admissions) shall be ranked according to the criteria specified at **Clause VI (refer to Guidelines for percentage of Reserved/ General seats at pages 13-17)**. Out of these candidates, the number of candidates to be called for GD & PI shall be eight times the number of seats in this category or the total number of eligible candidates whichever is lower. In case of a tie, the combined score of CAT-2025/ MAT 2025-26 and GD & PI would be used for deciding the candidate to be admitted.

SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

The candidates under reserved categories must submit the necessary certificate(s) required by the University in the prescribed preform given in the Handbook of Information-2026 along with their Admission Form (Pages 19-37)

CANCELLATION OF SEATS/ADMISSION

Admission of all such students who fail to attend at least 33% of the total lectures delivered and practicals held in all the papers during the first 10 working days from the start of teaching work in the course concerned shall be cancelled by the Board of Control/Joint Admission Cell after following the procedure given below:

- a. By the 12th day after the start of classes for a particular course, the names of those students who fail to attend at least 33% of the total lectures/tutorials/practicals etc. shall be put up on the Notice Board and Online Notice Board of the Department and also send a copy of the same to the office of the DUI . Within 4 days of the date of such notice, a student who is short of attendance may give in writing there as-ons for his/her absence from the classes.
- b. If a student does not submit an application in writing within the prescribed time as stated above, or the reasons adduced by the student in his application are not found to be sufficient and justified in the opinion of the Board of Control his/her admission shall be cancelled.
- c. All the seats thus falling vacant shall be filled strictly in the order of merit from the waiting list or through subsequent counseling before the expiry of the last date fixed for admissions by the University.
- d. When the admission of the student is cancelled as stated above, the Department shall display on the Notice Board and online Notice Board, the list of the person(s) next in the waiting list and make admissions accordingly.
- e. Approval of cancellation of admission and permission to fill up the cancelled seat(s) to be sought from the DUI.

NOTE: It is obligatory on the part of Departments to display vacant seats on the Online Notice Board of the Department. The candidates are advised to regularly browse the website.

MIGRATION

Migration from any other Business School/University/College **shall not be allowed.**

GUIDELINES FOR PERCENTAGE OF GENERAL/RESERVED SEATS*

IMPORTANT NOTE

The number of seats in each course offered in the Teaching Departments, as announced in the Admission Notice/s, shall be strictly adhered to, except for such minor adjustment as may be necessary on account of rounding of fractions to accommodate reservations, as given below:-

- 1) **55.5%** of the seats in each course shall be treated as belonging to the **General Category**.
- 2) **44.5%** seats shall be treated as belonging to the **Reserved Category**, as per details given below :-
 - (i) **15%** for candidates belonging to the **Scheduled Castes**.
 - (ii) **7.5%** for candidates belonging to the **Scheduled Tribes**.
 - (iii) **5%** for candidates belonging to **Backward Classes**.

The above reservation shall be subject the following conditions:

- a) The number of students admitted on merit of General Category shall not be included in the number of seats reserved;
- b) Members of Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall be allowed a concession of 5% marks for admission to the course in which a certain percentage of minimum marks has been prescribed provided they have obtained minimum pass marks prescribed by regulations;
- c) In case the seats earmarked of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes remain unfilled, a further relaxation in marks may be given, in order of merit inter-se amongst the candidates themselves, so that all the reserved seats are filled by candidates belonging to these categories. This, however, will not apply for M.B.B.S admissions: and
- d) A Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe person on migration from the State of his origin will not lose his status as Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe but he/she will be entitled to the concessions/benefits admissible to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes from the State of his origin and not from the State where he has migrated.[Regulation 29.1, P.U. Cal. Vol. 1, 2007 (Page 168)].
- (iv) **5%** seats will be horizontally reserved for persons or class of **persons with disability (PwD)**¹ out of which 1% each shall be reserved for persons suffering from the disabilities specified under the RPWD 2016 Act:

¹Claimant in this category should be capable of pursuing the course for which admission is sought. The Persons with Benchmark Disability (as per section 2(r) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPWD) Act 2016 should have a minimum of 40% disability duly certified by the Medical Board of District/State/UT/Medical Institution of National Importance. Such certificate shall be further certified by the Medical Board of the Panjab University Health Centre.

2. Intellectual disability: a) Specific learning disabilities b) Autism spectrum disorder

3. Mental behavior (Mental illness)

4. Disability caused due to

- a) Chronic neurological conditions due to : i) Multiple sclerosis ii) Parkinson's Disease
b) Blood Disorder: i) Haemophilia ii) Thalassemia iii) Sickle cell disease

5. Multiple Disabilities (Deaf Blindness)

6. Any other category as may be notified by the Central Government (Annexure–the Schedule of RPWD Act 2016, Page No.33,34,35)

a) If 5% of reservation of seats comes to 0.5 to 0.9, it shall be treated as one seat. However, if after calculating seats on the basis of 5%, the number of seats is divisible by 5, equal distribution of seats will be made for all the five categories. If after the division, any remainder is left, it shall be distributed on the basis of inter-se merit amongst all the five categories. If the seats after calculating on the basis of 5% comes to less than 5 it shall be distributed on the basis of inter-se merit amongst all the five categories.

b) In the absence of availability of candidates in any of the categories, the seats shall be inter changed inter-se.

c) If seats reserved for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities remained unfilled, these shall be treated in the sanctioned strength of seats for General Category. Applicants under the Reserved Category of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities shall be allowed a relaxation of 5% marks for calculation of merit in seeking admission to the courses in which a certain percentage of minimum marks has been specified, provided they have obtained minimum pass marks prescribed by the University regulations.

The candidate under the Reserved Category of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities shall be allowed an upper-age relaxation of 5 years for admission, in the courses wherever upper age restriction is applicable. A claimant who fraudulently avails or attempts to avail any benefit meant for persons with benchmark disability shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to 2 years or with fine which may extend to one lakh rupees or with both.

(v) 5% for candidates belonging to **Sports Category** (see separate guidelines on page 39).

(vi) 5% for candidates belonging to **Defence** (for all the under-mentioned categories taken together) who fall in one of following categories (which are given here in order of precedence):

1. Son/Daughter/Spouse of such Defence Personnel and CAPF Personnel² who died in action. (Only those who were wholly dependent on such personnel shall be considered).
2. Son/Daughter/Spouse as are wholly dependent on such Defence Personnel and CAPF Personnel who were in capacitated³ died while in service.
3. Defence and CAPF Personnel who were in capacitated while in service.
4. Son/daughter/spouse of ex-servicemen⁴ who are wholly dependent on them.

² CAPF earlier known as Para-military forces, includes Assam Rifles (AR), Border Security Force (BSF), Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), Indo Tibetan Border Police (ITBP), National Security Guard (NSG), Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) etc.

³ In capacitation will mean in capacitation leading to the discharge of the person by authorities concerned.

⁴ Ex-serviceman means a person who has served in any rank whether as a Combatant or non-combatant in the regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union **or in CAPF:**

- (i) Who retired from the service after earning his/her pensions ;or
- (ii) Who has been boarded **knout** of the service on medical grounds attributable to military service/**CAPF** or circumstance beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or
- (iii) Who has been released from the service as a result of reduction in establishment; or
- (iv) Who has been released from the service after completing the specific period of engagement, (otherwise than at his own request, or by way of dismissal, or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency) and has been given a gratuity.

Territorial Army Personnel of the following categories shall also be considered as ex-servicemen:

- a) Pension holders for continuous embodied service
- b) Disabled Territorial Army Personnel with disability attributable to military service
- c) Gallantry award winners.

5. Son/daughter/spouse of serving Defence Personnel and CAPF who are wholly dependent on them.
6. Ex-Servicemen.
7. Serving Defence personnel and CAPF personnel

Note: Except in the case of admission to evening courses, categories 2, 4 and 5 under 2(b) (vi) will not be considered, since the term “wholly dependent” will exclude such persons as are 'employed' or 'self-employed'.

- (vii) 2% for the Children/Grand Children of Freedom Fighters who have been sanctioned pension by Central/State Government or awarded Tamra Patra by Government of India (Syndicate Para 15, dated 30-5-1997) or those who have been certified to be Freedom Fighters by the Central/State Govt.
- (viii) Any other statutory reservation as prescribed by the Govt.of India, if any.

Additional Seats including NRI (Non-Convertible):

(a) Wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit/Kashmiri Hindu Families (non-migrants living in Kashmir Valley)

- i. Relaxation in cut-off percentage upto 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- ii. Increase in intake capacity upto 5% course-work.
- iii. Reservation of at least one seat in merit quota in technical/professional institutions.
- iv. Waving off domicile requirements.

Note: Seats in the above listed course is subject to the norms of Regulatory bodies.

Documents Required:-

- a. A candidate seeking admission against this seat is required to produce a certificate from an authorized Government Officer (i.e.Relief Commissioner/Deputy Commissioner of the concerned district/area) to the effect that the candidate is award of Kashmiri displaced person.
- b. Proof of current residence (such as Ration Card/Photo Identity Card issued by the Election Commissioner/Driving License/Aadhaar Card/Passport etc.)
- c. The admission of a candidate against this category shall be provisional subject to verification of his/her above mentioned certificates by the competent authority(vide syndicate para 4, dated 13.07.2020)

(b) One Girl Child out of the only two girl Children

- 1.) Two additional seats per unit per course subject to maximum limit of four (4) out of the two girl children from the session 2015-16 are created for admission to a given course in the Panjab University Teaching Departments, Regional Centres provided they are otherwise eligible from all angles. The additional seats will be only for those girl Children who are either a single girl child of her parents or one amongst the only two girl Children with no male Child. The additional seat will be available to only one of the two girl children of a couple.
 - Subject to notification by appropriate authority
- 2.) An undertaking to be obtained from the parents of the girl children declaring there in that the benefit of this scheme is being claimed for only One Girl Child out of the two girl Children and the parent shall not claim the same for the 2nd girl child elsewhere in future. The specimen of the certificate is enclosed.

(c) Cancer, AIDS and Thalassemia

One additional seat each for the student suffers from Cancer, AIDS and Thalassemia has been allowed for admission in each course in the Panjab University Teaching Departments, Regional Centres subject to the condition that the candidate seeking admission under each of these categories if otherwise

eligible from all angles. The claimant candidate will have to submit a certificate as a proof from the National Medical Institute like PGI, AIIMS etc.in support of his/her claims.

(d) Two Seats for Rural Area Students

Only those candidates will be considered in this category, who have passed their Matriculation and +2 examination from those rural schools that do not fall in the area of the Municipal Corporation/Municipal Committee/Small Town/Notified Area/Cantonment Area. A candidate claiming such benefits will have to produce a certificate from the D.E.O./Principal of the concerned institute of the area certifying that the school from where the candidate has passed the Matriculation and +2 examinations falls within the a fore said rural area.

(e) One seat for Border Area Students

The Border area students shall means those candidates who have passed the matriculation from a school situated in border area and 12th class from a school situated in any other area. A candidate claiming such benefit will have to produce a certificate from the Tehsildar or the Principal/ Headmaster/Head of the School certifying that the School from where the candidate has passed the matriculation falls within the aforesaid Border area.

(f) One Seat for Youth Festival

In all the teaching courses (except the courses governed by AICTE/NCTE/BCI /MCI/DCI etc.) being run in the Panjab University Campus including constituent colleges/regional centres/affiliated colleges, one additional seat is reserved per unit for those candidates who have excelled and out performed by their participation in the Youth Festivals. The candidate availing the aforesaid facility must fulfill the eligibility condition for admission to the particular course. For those courses to which the admission is to be done on the basis of entrance test, the candidate must have passed the entrance test. The selection of such candidates for admission to various courses at PU Campus/regional centres/constituent colleges/affiliated colleges, will be made by the respective admission committees. For recommending admission on the basis of youth festival participation, admission criterion will be fixed on the basis of merit as mentioned below and upon the verification of the original certificates of those candidate, who:

- (A) Have presented an item in an international cultural festival approved by Punjab Govt./Govt.of India/Panjab University.
- (B) Have got distinction in All India National Inter University Youth Festival organized by AIU/Govt. of India
- (C) Have got distinction in North Zone Inter University Youth Festival organized by AIU.
- (D) Have secured first/second/third position in Inter University Youth Festival organized by Govt. of Punjab/any State or Central University.
- (E) Have secured first/second/third position in Panjab University Inter Zonal Festival.

- (F) Have secured first/second/third position in Panjab University Zonal festival
- (G) Have secured first/second/third position in state level competition of State School Education Board of Punjab/Haryana/HP/or CBSE/ICSE or any other recognized board
 - Category A is considered as highest category followed by B, C....onwards.
 - Preference will be given to the candidate who represented Panjab University Chandigarh in A, B, C and D Categories.
 - Achievement(s) only during the preceding 3 years of the year of the admission will be considered.
- In case two or more candidate have equal position at equal level then:
 - i. Position secured in an Individual item shall be rated higher as compared to as a team.
 - ii. The eligibility of the candidate for participation in university youth festivals, in future, may also be considered.
 - iii. Academic record may be considered in case of tie between two or more candidate.

In case of any ambiguity, the related certificates be got verified from the Department of Youth Welfare through the concerned Chairperson / Principal /Head etc. The candidate admitted on the basis of youth festival additional quota seats shall have to give an assurance to the university authorities that during the duration of the course the candidate will participate in the activities associated with his item and will not create any kind of indiscipline. The admission committee will assess the participation of the candidate and in case the candidate does not fulfill their requirements, his admission may be cancelled. However, exemption can be given because of a special reason like sickness or any other unavoidable reason in Inter Varsity Youth Festivals, National Festivals and International Festivals.

(g) One additional seat for Transgender

One additional seat has been created for transgender students from the Session 2025-26 onwards in each course in the Panjab University Teaching Departments, Panjab University Regional Centres, Panjab University Constituent Colleges and the Colleges affiliated to the University, subject to the following eligibility conditions, provided the concerned Regulatory Body permits i) the candidate seeking admission is otherwise eligible as per Panjab University Rules. ii) the claimant candidate will have to submit a validated Transgender Certificate from the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment or Certificate of Identity as well as Identity Card issued by the District Magistrate as per the format given under “The Transgender Persons” (Protection of Rights) Rules, 2020 reach with the Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019.

(h) Two Seats for Orphan Children (One Male and One Female) in each programme of study, both at Undergraduate and Postgraduate level who have been rendered orphan. These two seats will be supernumerary. In case there is no eligible candidate available to fill the seat of male candidate, seat may be filled up from among the female eligible candidates, and vice-versa, so that the seats are filled from the needy portions of society.

(i) Categorization of International/NRI Students*

*Guidelines for International/ NRI Students are uploaded separately on the website <http://ubsldhadmissions.puchd.ac.in>.

Explanation for Calculation of category-wise seats and rounding off of fraction:

While working out the percentage of seats in the Reserved Categories as given above, if the number arrived at contains a fraction, this shall be resolved as follows:-

If the fraction is 0.5 or more, it shall be rounded off to 1; if it is less than 0.5, it shall be ignored. This shall, however, not affect the total number of seats in the General Category. To ensure this, If the total number of seats after making this adjustment, exceeds the prescribed number fixed for the course, the necessary additional seats shall be created with the prior permission of the D.U.I./Vice-Chancellor. Such seats, if created, shall be treated as additional only for the year in question.'

Illustration: In a course which has 35 seats, the distribution of seats among the various Categories will

The total number of seats is increased to 36 (as above), the 36th seats will be treated as additional seats in the course for that year only. (i) For State level competitions, the certificates issued by those recognised State/ U.T. (b)The concerned Association and its units/members/clubs must be registered under the concerned Centre/State Societies Registration Act.

(ii) For Inter State, National and International level Competitions the certificates issued by those concerned game recognised National Federations will be considered which have recognition/affiliation/renewal of recognition with the following during the period the candidate has participated in the last three years (i.e. 1st July 2023 to 30th June 2026) and four years in exceptional cases for outstanding sportspersons³ preceding the admission year (2026).

a) Ministry of Sports, Government of India (For sports events/games other than the Olympic Games - 2024 organised by International Olympic Committee)

And

b) Indian Olympic Association (For sports events/games organised in the Olympic Games-2024 by International Olympic Committee)

And

c) The International Federation of the concerned game recognised by National Olympic Committee of the concerned country duly affiliated with International Olympic Committee

And

- d) The concerned Federation and its units/members/clubs must be registered under the concerned Centre/State Societies Registration Act.**

(For further verification of sports certificates the candidate can be asked to submit the supporting documents as required by the office of Campus Sports.)

- 3. 3. Reservation under Sports Category is meant only for those active sportspersons¹ who participate in the Campus, University, State, National, International level sports tournaments. Such students will be considered for admission only if:**
- (i) their achievement in sports relates to their activities held each year in two different academic sessions in the same game and in the same event⁴ of the concerned game during Three years i.e. 1st July 2023 to 30th June 2026 (relaxable to Four years² in exceptional cases, on merit, for outstanding sportspersons³).**
- (ii) they are otherwise also eligible for participation in Inter College, Inter University tournaments as per latest eligibility rules available on website of Association of Indian Universities. Candidates applying for sports quota must also be eligible on the basis of age to participate in the Inter College and Inter University Competitions representing Panjab University for the next one year of their course duration after taking admission (as per eligibility rules of sports participation of Panjab University).**
- (iii) It is essential to qualify the process of screening of documents according to the provisions of the guidelines for reserved category of sports by the candidate for appearing in the sports counselling. The candidate whose required documents are found in conformity with the provisions mentioned in the guidelines will only be eligible for sports counselling. No document will be accepted after the date fixed for sports counselling.**
- (iv) The sports counselling includes verification of original documents as mentioned in the guidelines for reserved category of sports, qualifying the skill & game performance test and allocation of marks to the original sports certificates as per criteria given in Annexure-III subject to the other provisions of these guidelines for reserved category of sports. It is essential to show original documents for document verification on the day of sports counselling. The skill & game performance test will be conducted for those candidates only who qualify in the original document verification. The candidate has to qualify the skill & game performance test for allocation of marks to the original sports certificates for preparing sports merit.**
- (v) The games and their events for which Panjab University will send its teams for Inter University competitions for the preceding session of the admission session i.e. 2025-2026 (The Tentative list of games is at Annexure - IV).**

A person attending the grounds regularly so as to appear himself/herself for participation in the Inter College and Inter University & other sports tournaments. However, his/her age falls within the age group for which one is eligible for participation in Inter College/Inter University Competition.

2. Relaxable to Four years means from 1st July 2022 to 30th June 2026.

2. Outstanding Sportspersons means: - A person getting any of the first three positions or represented India in the Olympic Games /Paralympics Games/World Cups/World Championships/Asian Games/Asian Cups/Asian Championships/Commonwealth Games/Commonwealth Championships/ World University Games/ World University Championship for seniors juniors. A person getting any of the first three positions National University Games/ Khelo India Games during the session 2022-23, in those sports disciplines in which Panjab University sent its teams for participation in Inter University Competitions for the preceding session of the admission year i.e. 2025-2026.

4. Event referred in these guidelines means: -

Similarly, in the other games there are separate events of that particular game.

Inter University, State, National and International sports tournaments if selected. Their admission would be liable to be cancelled if the terms of the undertaking thus given are not adhered to.

- 6. 6. The order of precedence in the selection of candidate for admission will be as per achievement mentioned in the sports certificate of the candidate.**

The applicant securing higher marks (as per Annexure –III) in the best/highest submitted Merit / Participation Sports Certificates during the last three years i.e. 2023-2024 to 2025-2026 (relaxable to Four years² in exceptional cases, on merit, for outstanding sportspersons³) will be given higher preference.

In Case of Tie i.e. Applicants securing the same marks in the said evaluated Merit / Participation Sports Certificate in the same event of the same Game/Sport and eligible for admission in the same course may be resolved in the following order:

i) The marks in the second-best higher submitted Merit / Participation Sports Certificate shall be considered for allotment/admission in the course to break the tie.

ii) If the applicants have the same marks in the second best higher submitted Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate, then the marks in third best higher submitted Merit / Participation Sports Certificate shall be considered for allotment/admission in the course to break the tie.

iii) In case the tie still persists after evaluating the marks in third best higher submitted Merit / Participation Sports Certificate the tie shall be resolved by considering the "academic merit" i.e. as per admission criteria of the concerned department to which the admission is sought and even then if there is tie, it will be resolved by the seniority in age i.e. date of birth of the candidate and such tie will be resolved by concerned department in which applicant applied for admission.

- 7. 7. It is mandatory to participate actively in all sports competitions, if selected, and at least 75% attendance in Panjab University sports grounds is required to enable to sit in the examination for all the candidates admitted against reserved category of sports. The attendance certificates shall be issued by the Campus Sports Department in favour of each candidate whose attendance in sports grounds is at least 75% and admit card for examination shall be issued by the Chairperson only on the production of such a certificate.**

- 8. 8. When a candidate is required to abstain from the Department for preparation and participation in Inter College / Inter University / National / International / State Sports Tournaments, the candidate shall give prior information to the Chairperson of the concerned Department.**

- 9. 9. If a candidate admitted under the reserved category of Sports, remains absent from the grounds for regular practice for a continuous period of seven days without leave, his/her names shall be struck off the rolls by the Chairperson of the concerned Department on the recommendation of the Director Physical Education & Sports, Panjab University, Chandigarh.**

10. **10. Deficiency of equal numbers of lectures (theory, practical, seminars and tutorials etc.) shall be condoned for sportspersons for attending Trials, Coaching Camps, preparation and participation in various tournaments i.e. Inter Hostel and Inter Department (Conducted by P.U. Campus Sports), Inter College, Inter District, State, Inter State, Inter University, National and International level tournaments and all those tournaments for which gradation is being done including journey days.**
11. **11. In case a candidate does not attend the grounds for practice or does not participate in the P.U. Campus Sports Activities including Campus Annual Athletic Meet, Inter College Competition, Inter University Tournaments on medical grounds, the Medical Certificate issued by the University Chief Medical Officer only will be accepted.**

NOTE: In case a student remains present in the concerned Department for classes but remains absent in the grounds for sports then his/her Medical Certificate will not be accepted and his/her admission shall be liable to be cancelled.

12. **12. Certificate on Letter head will not be considered in normal course. However, if the certificates are not issued in the required format by some Sports Organization/Association in a particular game, those cases will be looked after separately by the screening committee on the recommendation of Campus Sports Department.**
13. **13. The Sr. No. 3 (i) and (ii) will not be applicable for Arjuna Awardeee / Rajiv Khel Ratan Awardee / Padam Shree Awardee / Olympians in any game/sports with the condition that if such a candidate is successful in getting admission but barred for participation due to age bar then he/she will coach or groom a team of his expertise for at least five hours a week without seeking any remuneration.**
14. **14. The admission of students under reserved category of sports will be provisional until the verification of sports certificates from the concerned issuing authority.**
15. **15. The D.U.I. has the authority to cancel admission at any time, if it is found that the candidate has obtained such admission on the basis of a false certificate or incorrect statement/record.**
16. **16. Second Round of Sports Counselling will be conducted, if the seats remain vacant in the concerned department under the sports category after exhausting the first sports merit list.**
